

# SNACK BAR RULES & DRESS CODE

1. SNACK BAR DUTY WILL REQUIRE ONE (1) REPRESENTATIVE PER PLAYER FOR THE ENTIRE SHIFT (5:30PM TO 9:30PM).
  - a. No more than two (2) (14 - 17 year olds) per shift.
  - b. Workers 14 - 17 can be runners or work fountain drink station only
2. SNACK BAR STATIONS: DEEP FRYER/GRILL (1); HOT DOGS (1); RUNNER (X2); NACHOS (1); PREP/RESTOCK (1); ORDER WINDOW/REGISTERS (X2); FOUNTAIN DRINKS (1).
3. ALL SNACK BAR VOLUNTEERS MUST BE 18 YRS OR OLDER.
4. THERE IS NO BUY OUT OPTION – IF A PARENT/GUARDIAN WISHES THEY MAY PAY SOMEONE TO WORK FOR THEM, THIS AGREEMENT IS SOLELY BETWEEN THE PARENT AND WORKER.
5. ABSOLUTELY NO FREE FOOD, CANDY, OR DRINKS SHALL BE GIVEN FROM THE SNACK BAR. ALL VIOLATORS WILL BE CHARGED FOR ANY ITEMS THAT ARE GIVEN OUT.
6. IF YOU ARE WORKING THE SNACKBAR FOR YOUR TEAM'S SHIFT, YOU ARE ALLOWED 1 FREE MEDIUM FOUNTAIN DRINK FOR YOURSELF.
7. FOOD MUST BE PURCHASED AND EATEN OUTSIDE THE SNACK BAR.
8. IF ASKED BY A COACH OR PARENT TO STORE TREATS OR FOOD FOR A TEAM, DIRECT THEM TO SPEAK WITH AN EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER FIRST.
9. PERSONS WISHING TO PURCHASE TEAM TICKETS FOR THEIR TEAM MUST COMPLETE THE TREAT TICKET FORM.
10. NO RUNNING, PLAYING OR LOITERING INSIDE THE SNACK BAR. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.
11. THE TEAM MANAGER WILL BE THE SNACK BAR LEAD FOR THE ENTIRE TEAM SHIFT. NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MAY OPERATE THE REGISTER, GRILL OR DEEP FRYER AT ANY TIME!
12. REGISTER DROPS ARE TO BE MADE ONLY BY AN EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER/S ON DUTY AND THE DESIGNATED REGISTER WORKER FOR THE SHIFT. ALL REGISTER DROPS REQUIRE A SNACK BAR TRANSFER SHEET: WHITE GOES IN WITH CASH, PINK STAYS IN REGISTER AND YELLOW GETS LOCKED UP FOR SECURITY PURPOSES.
13. ALL CANDY & FOOD IS INVENTORIED BEFORE AND AFTER ANY SHIFT.
14. CLOSING SHIFT MUST CLEAN \*see closing checklist posted in the snackbar\*
15. GLOVES ARE TO BE WORN IN THE SNACK-BAR AT ALL TIMES WHEN HANDLING FOOD.
16. ALL TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO WORK THEIR SCHEDULED SNACK BAR SHIFT. ANY TEAM NOT PRESENT FOR THEIR SHIFT WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TOURNAMENT.

**ANY PLAYER THAT DOES NOT HAVE A REPRESENTATIVE FOR THEIR TEAMS SNACK BAR DUTY SHIFT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A ONE (1) GAME SUSPENSION AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MANAGER.**
